15 Frank R. Burroughs Home Museum

This historic museum was built in 1889 and served as the home for local doctor Frank R. Burroughs. The home underwent an extensive renovation in 1902 when electricity came to Ritzville, creating a unique hybrid style. The museum underwent an extensive refurbishment in 1987-88 by a group of dedicated volunteers who now maintain the home. It was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1975.



16 Northern Pacific Railroad Depot Museum

214 W. Main Ave. • (509) 659-1936

Built in 1910 by the Northern Pacific Railroad Company, this was the second depot for Ritzville. During the early 20th century, Ritzville was the largest grain shipping railroad station in the world, which is why the large depot was built in such a small town. Burlington Northern donated the museum to the City of Ritzville in 1988, and the depot was placed on the National Register of Historic Places the following year.

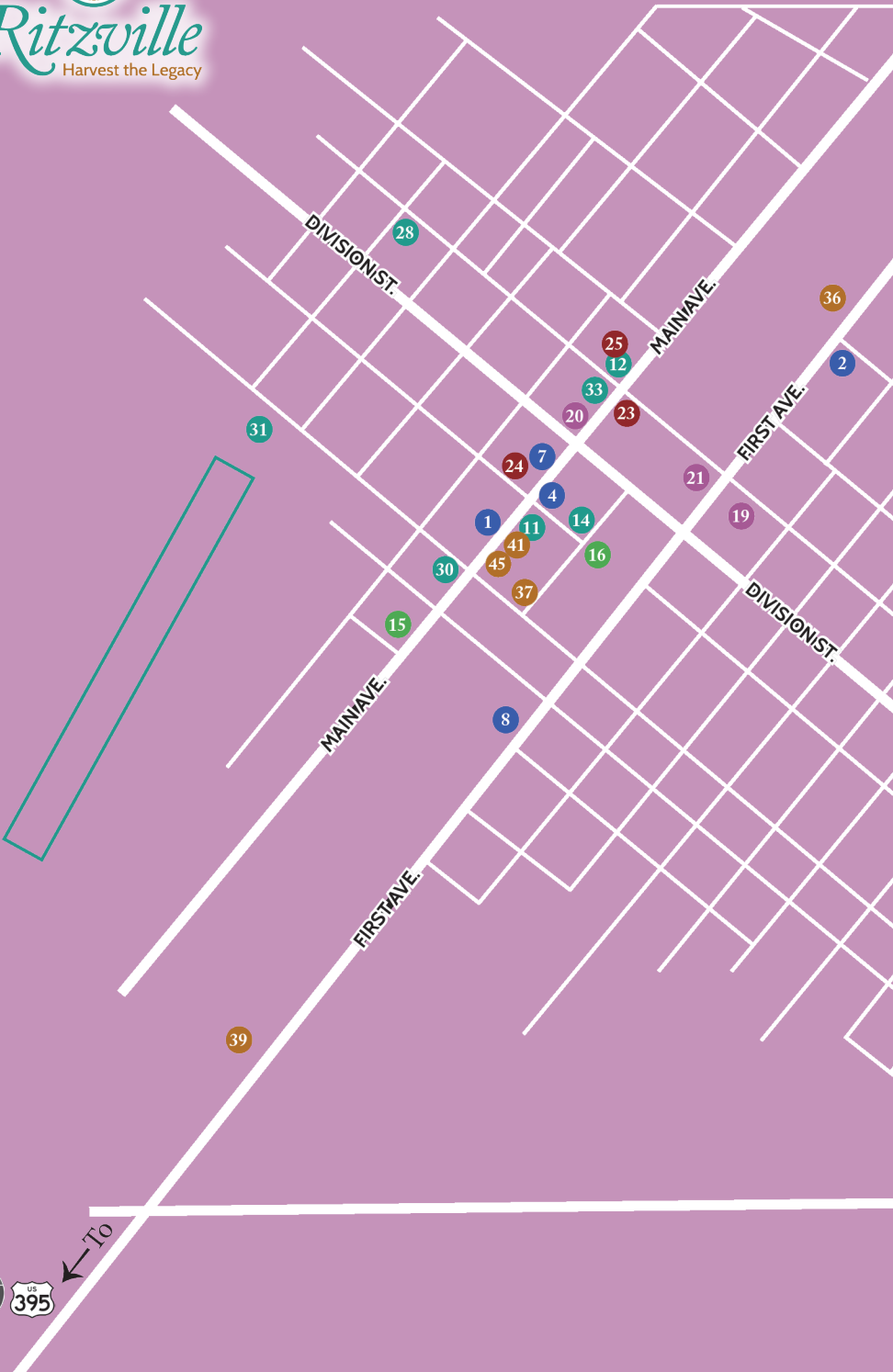

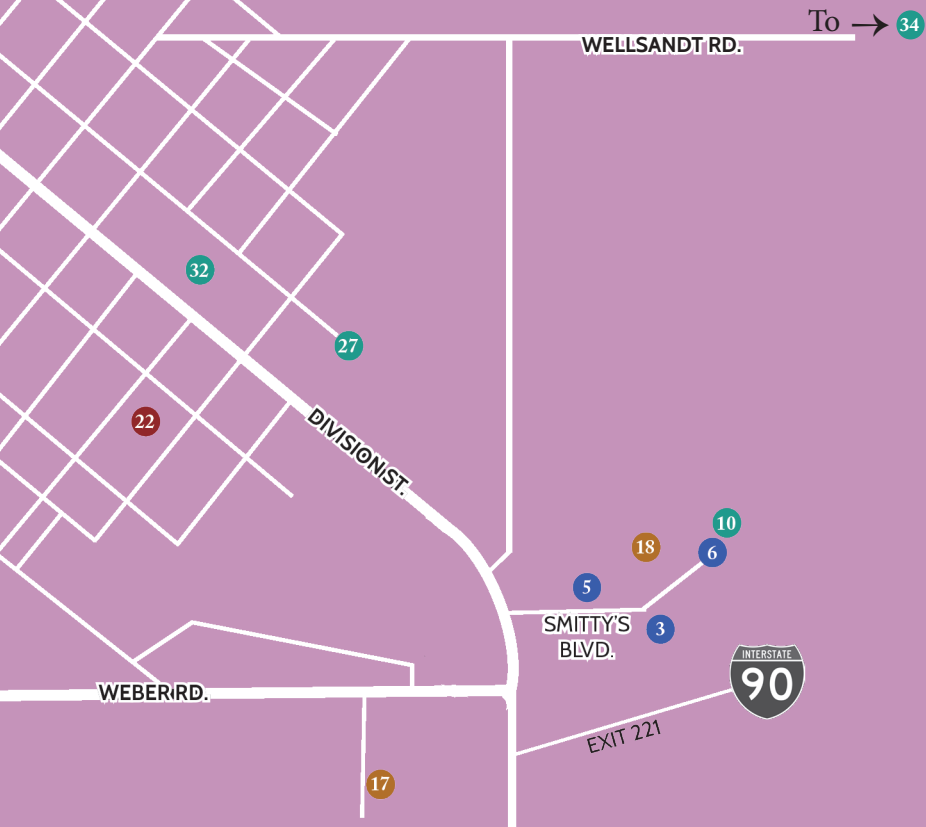
